What is Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Why is It Important ?

DRR are activities and practices to **reduce the risk and impact of disasters**. It is important because it is about taking action BEFORE disaster strikes. It's about being proactive and focusing on prevention, rather than letting disasters happen to you. And it is much less costly and stressful to prevent rather than to respond to disasters.

Community-Based DRR (CBDRR) and What It Means for You

CBDRR simply means that you as a **community member play a very important role in reducing disaster risks in your area**. That's because you know your surroundings best and can see changes that may warn you that something is not right. By working toegether with local governments and emergency first responders, you can become a local champion of CBDRR in your community.

- Become aware of the hazards and risks around you and share your concerns with your neighbours
- Be mindful that disasters may happen again if no action is taken
